## WHAT DOES AMERICAN BANK OF BEAVER DAM DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Social Security number and <b>income</b></li> <li>▪ <b>account balances</b> and <b>transaction history</b></li> <li>▪ <b>credit history</b> and <b>credit scores</b></li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share <b>customers'</b> personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their <b>customers'</b> personal information; the reasons <b>American Bank of Beaver Dam</b> chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## What we do

How does American Bank of Beaver Dam protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does American Bank of Beaver Dam collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- **open an account**      or    **deposit money**
- **pay your bills**        or    **apply for a loan**
- **use your credit**        or    **debit card**

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

## Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include financial companies such as, American National Wealth Management.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Nonaffiliates we share with can include direct marketing companies, and financial service companies such as financial brokerage companies.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Our joint marketing partners include direct marketing companies, and financial service companies such as financial brokerage companies.*
